Each month we aim to have one guest speaker, and in the near future will welcome Clive Jones, former pastor of Staplehurst Free Church, on 18th June, and the Rev Lorraine Apps-Huggins on 16th July. She is the assistant chaplain of The Living Well which is a centre for healing and wholeness based in Nonington (*www.the-living-well.org.uk*). In the autumn our speakers include Brother Christopher OGS, the director of the Loseley Christian Cancer Help Centre, and the Rev Colin Terry who is setting up an Anna Chaplaincy in partnership with the Heart of Kent Hospice.
